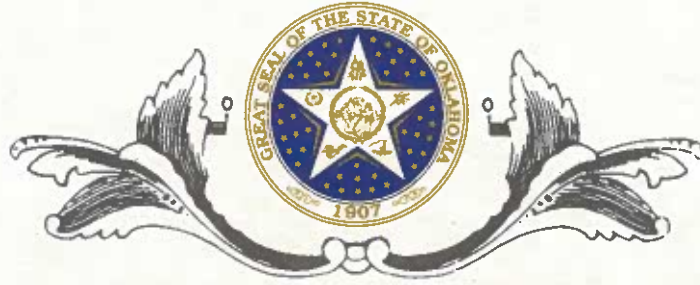

Proclamation

Whereas, President Donald J. Trump earned widespread support in Oklahoma during the 2016, 2020, and 2024 general elections, securing victory in all 77 counties; and

Whereas, on November 5, 2024, Americans overwhelmingly re-elected President Donald J. Trump for a second term, reaffirming their confidence in his leadership; and
